**MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD**

**SUBJECT: Government Meal Rate (GMR) MOI for School code 1012/1042 Courses (1 February – 31 January 2027).**

1. Students attending ATRRS courses at 166th REGT (RTI) during the time frame 1 February – 31 January 2027 are directed to eat provided meals at the 166<sup>th</sup> REGT (RTI) Dining Facility (DFAC) without any requirement to pay for government provided meals. The standard GMR is not required on Defense Travel System (DTS) travel authorizations for military students attending ATRRS courses at the 166<sup>th</sup> REGT (RTI).
2. Pennsylvania Army National Guard (PAARNG) AGR and Long Tour ADOS students residing within 50 miles of Fort Indiantown Gap are not authorized meal reimbursement in DTS and must pay full meal rate for every meal they choose to consume in the 166th REGT (RTI) contracted DFAC. Courses counsel these Soldiers and will not direct these students to eat in the dining facility. AGR and Long Tour ADOS Soldiers that choose to eat in the contract dining facility, will be charged the full meal rate and will not be reimbursed in accordance with Joint Travel Regulation (JTR).
3. M-Day students conducting ATRRS training in an IDT, AT, or YRAT status that live within 50 miles of Fort Indiantown Gap are not entitled to per diem. IDT, AT, and YRAT meals are funded by the PA-G4. IDT, AT, and YRAT meals provided by the 166th REGT (DFAC) are deducted when processing pay in My Unit Pay (MUP).
4. Students use the DFAC for all meals for the duration of the course. Students will report which course they are attending at the headcount station for each meal they consume.
5. The 166<sup>th</sup> REGT (RTI) will provide a statement of nonavailability when the DFAC is not operational. Students must coordinate the meal entitlement with their unit prior to arriving for training.
