

Scheduling an OPI

In order to be eligible to schedule an OPI, you must meet one or more of the following requirements per AR 11-6, Army Foreign Language Program, para 2-5c.

- Language on the ASLL or mission required language for which no DLPT exists
- Language for which no DLPT exists
- Language qualified 35Ms, FAOs, CMFs 18, 37, and 38 with a speaking requirement
- Enabling a linguist (MOS immaterial) who achieved proficiency levels of L3/R3
- All ARSOF Soldiers may request an OPI
- A Soldier who receives a L3/R3 on their DLPT and the language is on the ASLL
- ARSOF Soldiers (CMFs and AOCs 18, 37, 38R, 38S, 38W, 38Z, and 180A) are eligible to take a two-score oral proficiency interview (TSOPI)
